

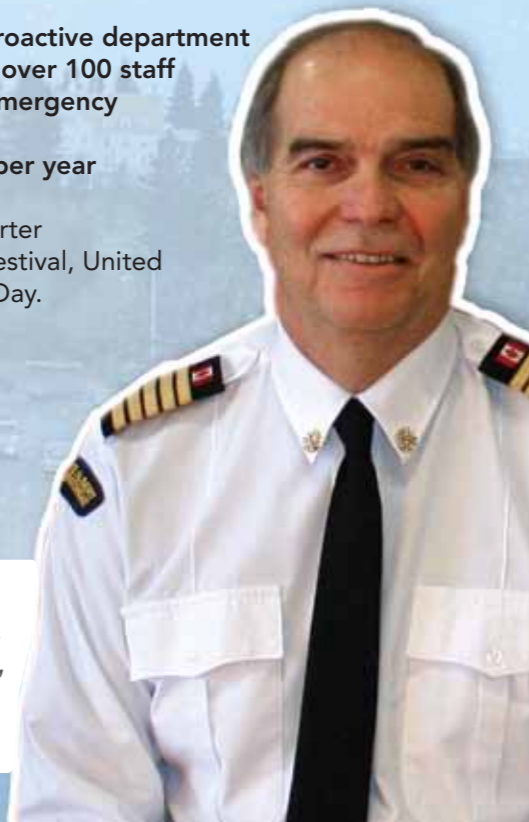

Job Requirements

The City of St. Albert proudly operates a fully integrated emergency services department which provides superior paramedic (ALS) ambulance service and dedicated fire and rescue services.

- **Fire Fighting Training (NFPA 1001 or equivalent)**
- **Emergency Medical Technologist - Paramedic (EMT-P) certification from the Alberta College of Paramedics**
- **Preference given to Emergency Medical Technologist - Paramedics**
- **Class 3, 4 Alberta drivers license with air endorsement and less than 7 demerits**

Recruitment Process

- aptitude test
- physical fitness test
- interview
- job-related test
- criminal record search (vulnerable sector screening)
- medical evaluation
